2. Town Council resolution

Having considered:

- the agreed importance of keeping car parking free at the point of use, for its contribution to the social and economic well-being of the Town and its attendant communities;
- the mandate given to the Town Council from the community at a public meeting to keep car parking free at the point of use; and
- the report of the Car Parks Working Group established at the above meeting to inform councillors' decisions;

the Town Council resolved:

that the Vice-Chair be asked to write to South Norfolk Council to enquire whether SNC would agree to discuss **in principle** the proposal that the Town Council be offered the car parks, as a free at point of use public facility, on a long-term lease at a peppercorn rent, with full responsibility for management and maintenance, including resurfacing.

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
