(REDENHALL WITH HARLESTON) (EMERGENCY NOTICE)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION 2020
Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to the likelihood of danger arising to the public due to Covid-19 and the need to undertake social distancing measures, considers it is necessary and expedient to introduce the following measures and restrictions and that these measures and restrictions should come into effect without delay in the **TOWN OF REDENHALL WITH HARLESTON**:-

A. The use by vehicles of the following roads will be temporarily prohibited:-

C571 The Thoroughfare from its junction with U76018 Exchange Street to its junction with U76536 Bullock Fair Close;

C877 Swan Lane from its junction with U71084 Weavers Croft to its junction with C571 The Thoroughfare;

U76018 Exchange Street from its junction with C571 London Road to its junction with U76016 Old Market Place; and

U76017 Church Street from its junction with U76017 Broad Street to its junction with C571 London Road;

B. The following road will be subject to the temporary imposition of a one-way system (southbound):-

U76016 Old Market Place from its junction with U76018 Exchange Street to its junction with U76017 Broad Street;

C. The following road will be subject to the temporary suspension of the 11 parking bays and no vehicle will be permitted to park or stop:-

U76017/50 between Church Street and Exchange Street.

The existing Traffic Orders relating to parking in this location will be temporarily suspended to facilitate this prohibition whilst the need for the measures exists.

The temporary traffic management measures will be in place for 21 days during the period 15th June and 5th July 2020, when signs are in place. Due to the unknown period the restrictions may be required, these measures will be continued with a Temporary Traffic Order to be in place for up to 18 months.

Alternative signed routes will be provided for traffic whilst the traffic management measures are in place.

If a vehicle (other than an emergency vehicle on emergency business) is left in contravention of any waiting restriction provisions imposed by this Notice a penalty charge shall be payable.

In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge is payable, a penalty charge notice may be issued in accordance with the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 (as amended in 2015).
