


NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (REDENHALL WITH HARLESTON)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION ORDER 2020
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14(1)

ORDER restricting the use by vehicles of the C571 London Road from a point 18 metres north of its junction with the C205 Wilderness Lane for a distance of 110 metres northwards in the TOWN OF REDENHALL WITH HARLESTON

1. Save as provided in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order and whereas the Norfolk County Council as Traffic Authority for the Administrative County of Norfolk is satisfied that:-
 - (i) Norfolk County Council footway resurfacing works are required at the C571 London Road from a point 18 metres north of its junction with the C205 Wilderness Lane for a distance of 110 metres northwards in the TOWN OF REDENHALL WITH HARLESTON (hereinafter referred to as the said road) and:
 - (ii) that in consequence, traffic over the said road will be temporarily prohibited to park, stop or load/unload with effect from 20th July 2020 to 21st August 2020 for the duration of the works expected to be about 33 days within the period.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply:
 - (a) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or civil enforcement officer;
 - (b) to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of road to which this Order applies.
3. This Order has a maximum duration of 18 months and will be revoked upon completion of the works. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Order the operational period of this Order may become extended to allow completion of the works after obtaining consent of the Secretary of State.

NOW THEREFORE the Norfolk County Council DO HEREBY ORDER, that with effect from 20th July 2020 to 21st August 2020 for the duration of the works the said road SHALL BE RESTRICTED insofar as the parking or loading/unloading of vehicles will be PROHIBITED.
