

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the A143 Harleston Bypass from its junction with the C361 Wells Lane to its junction with the C565 Mendham Lane in the TOWN OF REDENHALL WITH HARLESTON because of bridge joint replacement works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) between 18:00 and 09:30 hours from 12th September 2020 to 13th September 2020 and between 18:00 and 09:30 hours from 19th September 2020 to 20th September 2020 for the duration of the works, expected to be 2 nights within the period.

Alternative route is via: A143 Harleston Bypass/ Brockdish Needham Bypass/ Scole Road/ Bungay Road/ Lower Street/ Bungay Road/ Scole Stuston Bypass, A140 Scole Bypass/ Dickleburgh Bypass/ Ipswich Road/ The Street/ Norwich Road/ Ipswich Road/ Ipswich Road Roundabout (Harford Junction), A47 Southern Bypass, A146 Trowse Junction Loddon Road/ Loddon Bypass/ Beccles Road/ Norwich Road/ Stockton Roundabout, A143 Yarmouth Road/ Broome Bypass/ Bungay Road/ Old Railway Road/ Bungay Road/ Harleston Bypass (Newton Flotman, Burston and Shimpling, Brockdish, Holverston, Earsham, Wacton, Ashby St Mary, Caistor St Edmund and Bixley, Brome and Oakley, Hellington, Trowse with Newton, Kirby Bedon, Scole, Alington, Swainsthorpe, Bungay, Hales, Yelverton, Wortwell, Chedgrave, Stoke Holy Cross, Stockton, Framingham Pigot, Stuston, Broome, Loddon, Sisland, Redenhall with Harleston, Needham, Kirby Cane, Ellingham, Tasburgh, Pulham Market, Long Stratton, Keswick and Intwood, Alburgh, Thurton, Bergh Apton, Saxlingham Nethergate, Dickleburgh and Rushall, Ditchingham, Denton, Gillingham, Tivetshall).


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

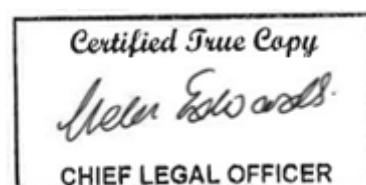
In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
